APPLICATION FOR PRE-KINDERGARTEN:

All pre-kindergarten applicants **MUST** apply by completing the Department of Education's universal pre-kindergarten application at nyc.gov/prek.

- Pre-kindergarten applications for the 2017 - 2018 school year will be accepted between January 17 and February 24, 2017 and offer letters will be distributed in April 2017.
- All NYC families with children born in 2012 are eligible to apply to pre-kindergarten.
- Storefront Academy Harlem admits 18 pre-kindergarten students each year.
- All students admitted into Storefront Academy Harlem's pre-kindergarten class continue to kindergarten without a need to reapply.



APPLICATION FOR GRADES K - 7

- Applications are accepted for students in grades K-7, though availability is limited.
- Applications received by April 3, 2017 will have priority consideration for the 2017-2018 school year. Any applications submitted after this date will be waitlisted.
- Applicants must re-apply each school year.
- A separate application must be completed for each child.

Storefront Academy Harlem provides a comprehensive education to students from pre-kindergarten through 8th grade on our campus on East 129th Street. Our classrooms boast an ideal student/teacher ratio, with 18 students per class, and two teachers per class in our early. We partner with families and community members to prepare children academically, socially and emotionally for further education while empowering each child to reach his or her potential.

In fall 2015, Storefront Academy Harlem replicated its proven academic model and opened Storefront Academy South Bronx, a public charter school in the Mott Haven section of the Bronx. With the opening of the South Bronx campus, Storefront Academy's impact expands by almost 60%, and by the time of full enrollment in the South Bronx, Storefront Academy's impact will nearly triple.

Our approach sets us apart.

Our successes speak volumes, and are credited to our unique and holistic approach to education founded on two core components: academic rigor and strategic nurturing.

- **Strong Academic Program and Personalized Instruction**

Storefront Academy Harlem boasts a rigorous, common-core aligned, and student-driven academic program. We recognize that a curriculum that is challenging, culturally relevant and grounded in literature lays a strong foundation for academic success. Our commitment to students of all academic abilities is reflected in our widely diverse student community. We integrate research-based academic interventions, intentionally small class sizes, discussion-based curricula and project-based learning, with the goal of striking a balance between a traditional and progressive academic program to truly meet the unique needs of all of our students.

- **Social and Emotional Support**

At Storefront Academy Harlem, we nurture the whole child. We offer a diverse portfolio of social and emotional programming, including character education, group and individual counseling, and conflict resolution. Our faculty intentionally build strong relationships with our students and their families, which is a cornerstone of our program. Additionally, our school-wide core values are designed to strengthen self-understanding and provide tools to manage and respond to conflicts and appreciate diversity.

- **Enrichment Programming**

Our visual arts, music, and movement programs expose students to a variety of experiences and many ways to express themselves. Students study global arts and cultures and engage in long-term projects to deepen their understanding. Additionally, students in all grades participate in field trips in and around New York City, which encourage them to explore the world around them, to challenge themselves, to create and imagine.

Storefront Academy provides a robust academic and enrichment program, which supports our 8th grade graduates high-performing high schools:

- 100% of Storefront Academy's graduates attend private, parochial or selective public secondary schools
- Since 2001, 95% of Storefront Academy's graduates have received their high school diploma, far surpassing the New York City average of 73%.
- 100% of our male students graduate from high school, significantly higher than the national average of 59%.
